

What usually happens.

At the beginning of the Service, the Minister stands up to signal for the Bible to be brought into the church - if able, members of the congregation should also stand up.



Water and glasses are available in the sanctuary near the old organ console .



A member of the congregation will welcome folk to worship and announce the first hymn and as the service progresses, others will be involved in leading prayers and readings.



The children in our Young Church are invited to come to the front for the Children's Address. Adults sometimes accompany the toddlers. After the Children's hymn, they all go downstairs to continue with work appropriate to their age.

There is a crèche. Some parents accompany the children downstairs, then return when the younger ones have settled.


During the service, the Duty Team will pass bowls around as an Offering is uplifted. Many members give by Standing Order so it is normal for folk to pass the plate along the row without seeming to contribute.



There is no obligation to make an offering, but we will be very grateful for any contributions towards the wider work of the Church and upkeep of our building.

After the last hymn, please remain standing for the Benediction and the Three-fold Amen.

Many folk stay and listen to the organ voluntary after the service.

Tea / coffee & biscuits are served in the Coffee Bar downstairs and there is an opportunity to meet with others and chat.



At, both the main and Informal Communion, we share at an 'open table' and you are invited to partake "*if you love the Lord a little and would like to love Him more*".

The bread is served to everyone and we wait for Ken to indicate when we should all eat together - similarly with the wine. We use individual glasses and the inner ring of glasses contains non-alcoholic wine.
